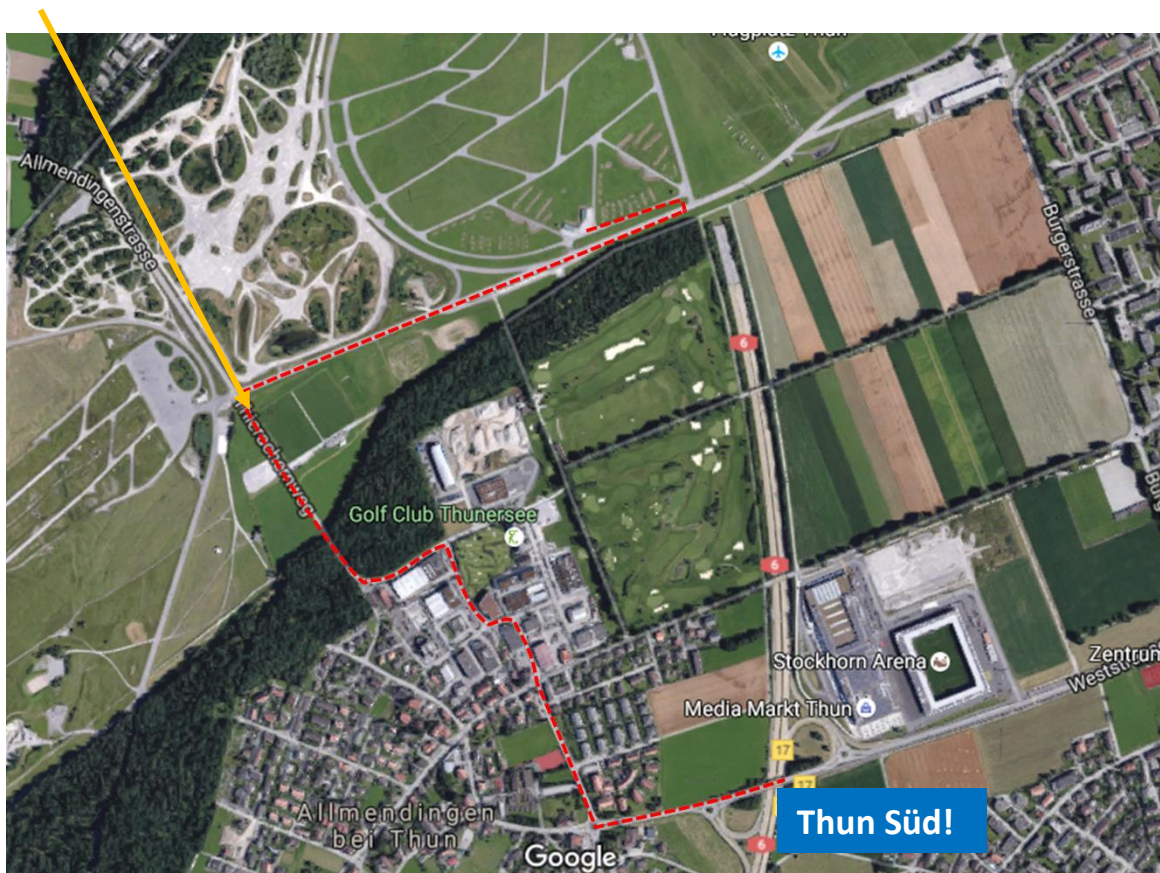

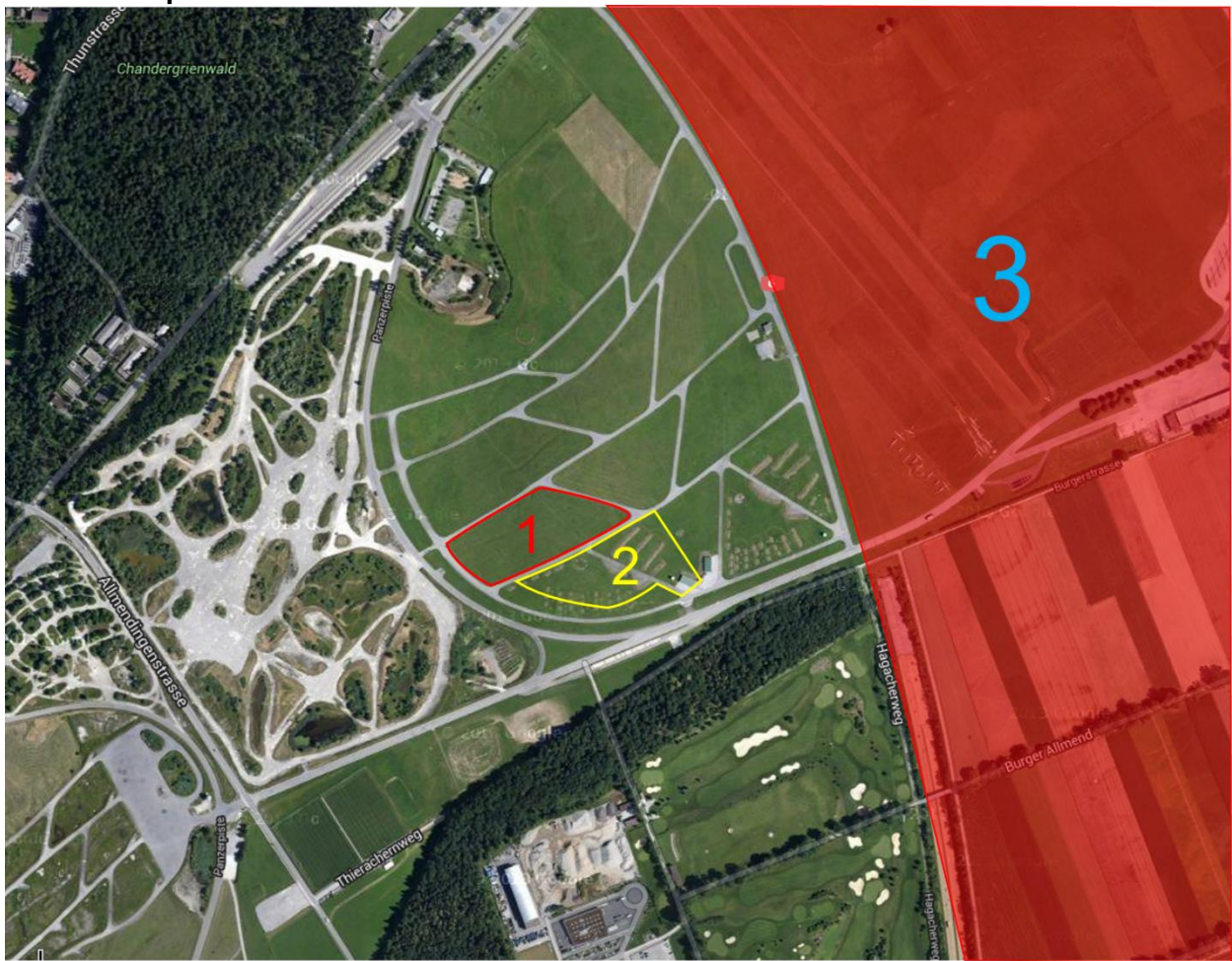
The Gate is located at 46°44'55.7"N 7°35'25.3"E (46.748798, 7.590349)..

14.1. Disposition

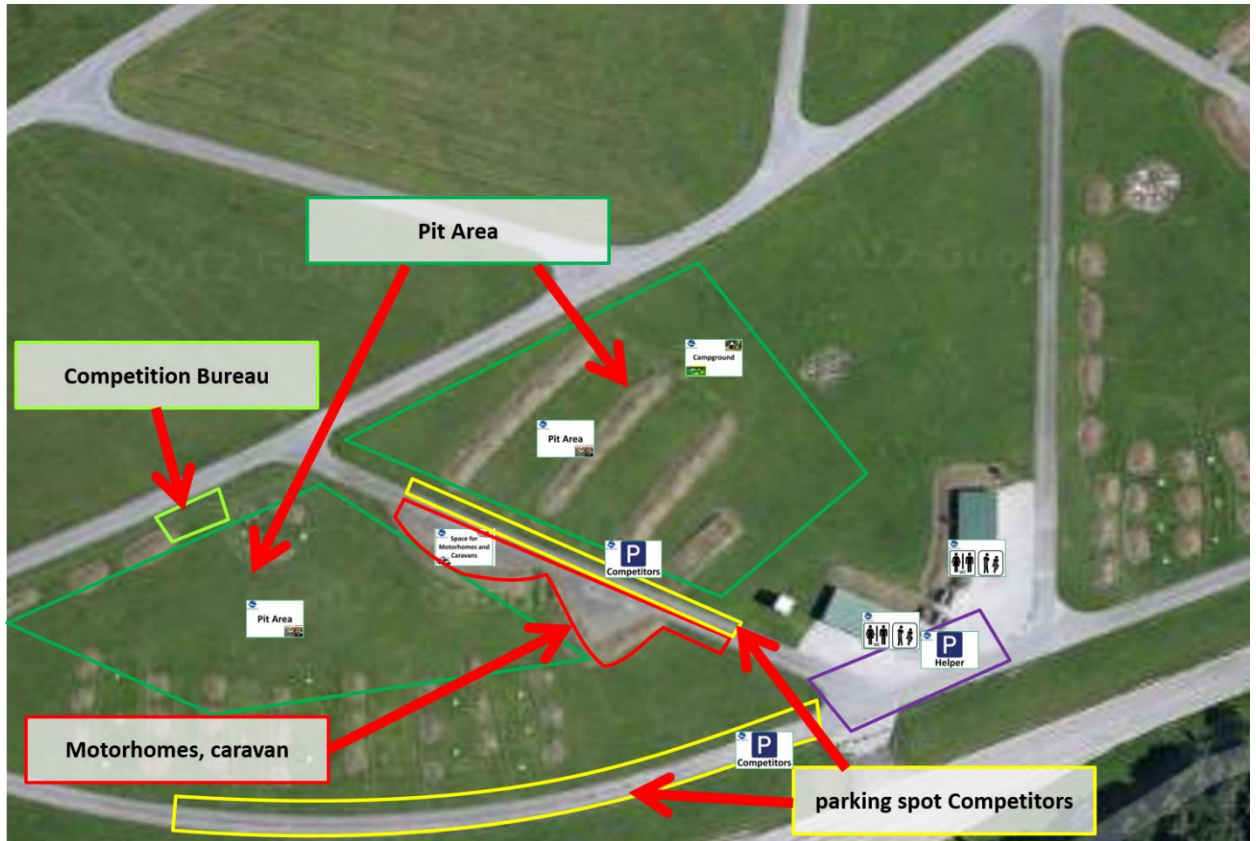


- 1: Flyingfield

14.2. Local rules

- The no fly zone needs to be respected at all times. Violations will be penalized according to chapter 5.7.4.4. Forbidden airspace (FAI Sporting Code Section 4 – Aeromodelling class F3K). Participants can be excluded from the contest by the contest director for repeated violation of the forbidden airspace.
- In the north eastern part of the contest site there is a possibility of man carrying sailplanes passing at a minimum altitude of 250m.
- Participants should stay below 250m in that part of the site or immediately leave the airspace on appearance of a man carrying sailplane.
